Minimally Processed Honey ~ FAQ

Clark's of Colorado honey is minimally processed and lightly filtered.

- Clarity: Processed honey is finely filtered, so it looks smooth and crystal-clear without specks of pollen, wax, or propolis.
- Slower crystallization: Processed honey stays liquid much longer.
- Easier to pour: Stays runny longer, making it simpler to drizzle into tea, over food, or into recipes.
- Honey is a wholesome alternative to refined sugar.

Customer Question #1:

If the honey is filtered, is there still pollen in the honey?

Yes — there will still be pollen in honey that's filtered with a 200 μm (micron) filter.

Here's why:

Size of pollen vs. filter size

- Most pollen grains are much larger than 200 μm
 - Actually, typical honey bee-forage pollen ranges from 15–100 μm in diameter
- A 200 μm filter removes:
 - Beeswax flakes
 - Larger debris
 - Bee parts
 - Clumps of pollen stuck together

But individual pollen grains are small enough to pass through a 200 μm mesh.
